Senior Capstone Experience Website

One major, required component of your Senior Capstone Experience is the development of a website that you will share with the public via the Senior Experience page on the Menno School website as well as with the judges as part of your presentation. You can find a sample Senior Experience page on the Senior Experience link on the Menno School website.

Notice that on the sample Senior Experience page, you will start by filling in the following information:

What: I have chosen.... for my Senior Experience.

Who: I am at senior at Menno High School with an interest in...

Mentor(s): My mentors(s) will bewho have expertise in my chosen field because they...

Faculty Advisor: My faculty advisor is...

Your website needs to include the following:

- 1) A journal or timeline that includes an entry for each day/time that you worked on your Senior Experience.
- 2) Photos or videos that will verify your work. Examples: If you spent time working on a product that you created, take photos and videos showing each stage of your work from beginning to end. If you hosted a presentation about your topic, have some take photos or videos of your presentation. If you organized an event, get photos or videos of the event and your work at that event. If you volunteered your services or observed an activity outside of school, get photos or videos of your participation in that service or observation of that activity. If you interviewed someone regarding your research topic or product, get a photo of video of the interview.
- 3) All of the documents that are required as part of your Senior Capstone Experience. These documents include your letter of intent, research paper, letter to the judges, and reflection.
- 4) As the school year progresses, you may want to enhance your Senior Experience website by adding more information, such as links to the information that you used in your research paper, etc.

Be creative and make your website a part of the Senior Experience that you will be proud of.
